## **Management of Parkinson's Disease: Taking It One Patient at a Time**

### Program Description

Parkinson's disease (PD) is a chronic, progressive, neurodegenerative disorder that is characterized by tremor, rigidity, slowness of movement, and related disability. Treatment of PD is complex and highly individualized by a variety of patient characteristics and the clinician's awareness and perception of available treatment options. Tailoring disease management on a patient-by-patient basis is essential to maximize therapeutic benefits, minimize side effects, improve adherence to the treatment regimen, and impact patient outcomes. This educational program will include information on individualized patient assessment, treatment strategies for different stages of disease, surgical therapy for more advanced stages of PD, and techniques for optimizing adherence to treatment throughout the course of disease.

### Learning Objectives

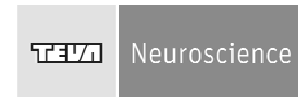
